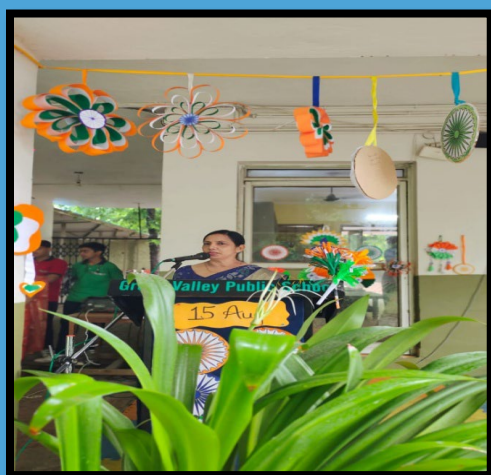

Two days Inhouse Teachers Training was conducted in Green Valley Public School from 26-09-25 to 27-09-25 .Dr. Mukta Mishra and Dr. Mudita Yadav were the resource persons.

DAY-1: The resource person, Ms Mukta Mishra started the session in a very interesting way. She asked the ways of assessment practiced in school and then,she discussed about mindful ways of assessment. Ms. Mudita stressed on multiple assessment strategies in our daily practice, such as, peer assessment, self-assessment, concept maps, exit card, visual assessment, reflections, journals, etc. Ms. Mukta also discussed about the challenges faced by teachers in incorporating the cycle of curriculum, classroom transaction and assessments. She divided these challenges and also discuss about making rubrics .

DAY-2: Second day started with a video and the resource person discussed about the uniqueness of every child and suggested that during formative assessments students can be assessed as per their individual capabilities and focused on the competency based learning, i.e., student's demonstration of desired learning outcome should be in the center of the learning process. Structure of assessment in Grade IX & X was discussed in detail, especially the co-scholastic portion. Then the resource persons discussed about the pattern of question paper ,framing the question paper ,increasing the assessment of fundamental skills in real world contexts, diagrams and other visual material based questions, higher thinking skills such as analyzing and evaluation, etc. and provided us insight to the Assessment and Evaluation Practices.

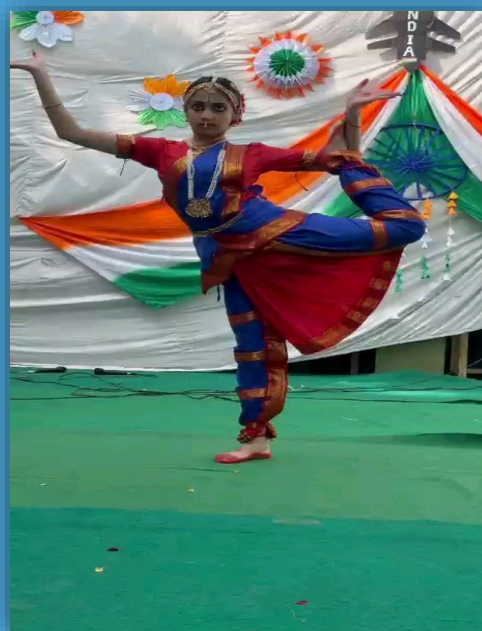

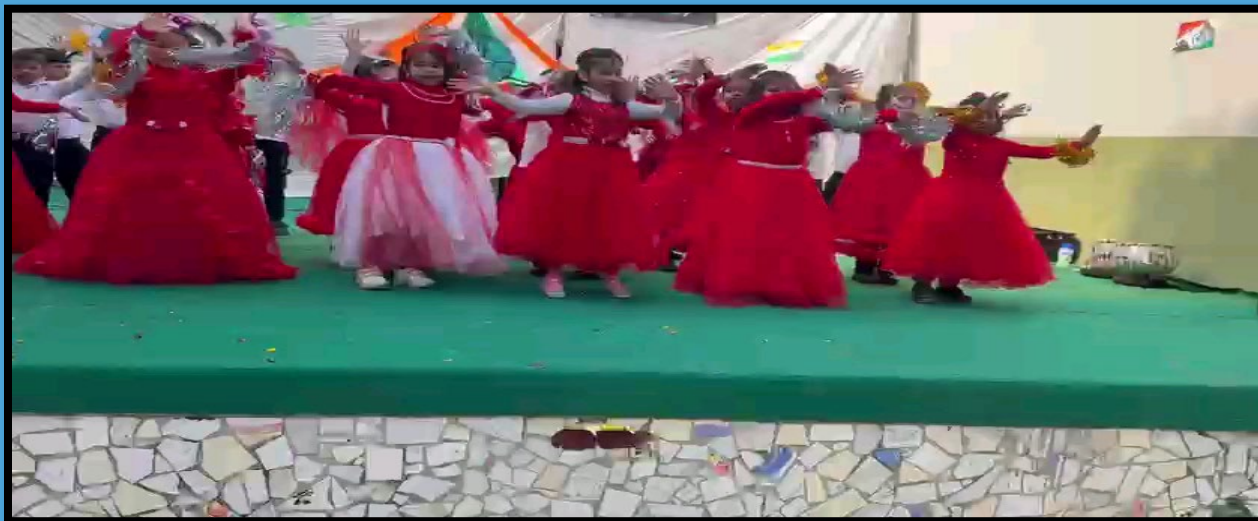
